

### EJEMPLOS PARA LAS PREGUNTAS 3 Y 4 (NUEVAS)

#### 3.- Read this conversation between two people. Complete their conversation. Write the numbers (1-7) and each complete sentence on your exam paper. (2 points)

Jenny and Frank are strangers staying in the same holiday resort. They have just started chatting to each other. This is half of the conversation they have had.

Jenny: Where (1).....are you from / do you come from?

Frank: From Germany. Actually from a small village near Dortmund. And you?

Jenny: Well, I'm from Ireland originally, but I live near London. It's nice here, isn't it? Have (2) .....you ever been to London before?

Frank: No, I haven't. It's my first visit. But it is very nice. You're right. I think I'll come here again next year.

Jenny: I hope you don't mind my saying so, but your English is very good. How long (3).....have you been studying English...?

Jenny: You see, (7) my mother will be eighty next Saturday and I haven't seen her for a long time.

2.- Your father says: "There's no milk left in the fridge."

3.- Your teacher congratulates you on an excellent piece of work you've written.

7.- You didn't make your bed this morning. You want to apologise.

I'm sorry mum, I got up too late and didn't have time to make my bed.  
I'm sorry, you know I never leave the house without making it but I had to finish a report.

8.- Your uncle invites you to the cinema but it's been a very busy day and you are feeling very tired.

Thanks for your invitation but I am too tired to go to the cinema today.  
I'm afraid I'm too tired. Why don't you leave it for tomorrow?
